

Step 5 Proof of Identity

This step is for people who do not have a driver licence, passport or firearms licence

You will need to ask someone who can confirm your identity to fill in this section. If you are unable to get someone to confirm your identity, then you will need to make a statutory declaration. This form can be obtained from your local District Court or go to www.justice.govt.nz/services/criminal-records

The person who confirms your identity must:

- ✓ have known you for more than 12 months
- ✓ be aged 18 years or over
- ✓ have a daytime phone number and be contactable during normal business hours
- ✗ not be a relative (a relative is a person connected by blood or marriage), and
- ✗ not live at the same address.
